Dear Patients and Friends of Sorgen Dentistry,

In light of the rapidly changing status of the coronavirus (COVID-19), we have made the difficult decision to suspend all but emergency dental care for three weeks, with the hope and anticipation that we will be able to return to normal business operations on Monday, April 6th. Our decision is driven by our concern for the health and well-being of our patients and our team, as well as specific recommendations recently set forth by the American Dental Association (ADA) and Oklahoma Dental Association (ODA).

Despite our ongoing efforts to follow the ADA guidelines for maintaining a sterile environment, there is still a high risk for transmission in the dental office setting due to aerosol plumes distributed by dental handpieces and certain hygiene instruments. We do not feel that we, in good conscience, can ask our staff or patients to be present in the office when so many people may be contagious but asymptomatic.

We appreciate everyone's patience and are optimistic that this pandemic will run its course as quickly and painlessly as possible. We also plead with you to follow the CDC's social distancing recommendations as closely as you can to ensure the health and well-being of those around you.
